Do you like robots? Do you enjoy science? If so, then join us as the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA) presents the 2015 Robotics Challenge Finals at Fairplex, connecting students, scientists, first responders & robots.

JUNE 5 AND 6  
8 A.M. – 5 P.M.

The DARPA Robotics Challenge is a competition of human-robot teams testing technology developed to help emergency personnel respond to natural and man-made disasters. DARPA will bring together 25 teams from around the world to compete for \$3.5 million in prize money.

Future scientists can try their hand at controlling robots and other gadgets, and meet technology developers and emergency responders at the Technology Exposition. The more than 70 demonstrations and exhibits include:



## Demonstrations:

- First Responders performing disaster response operations
- A robotic “cheetah,” a robotic dog named “Spot” and bipedal and humanoid robots including NASA’s Valkyrie and Oregon State’s ATRIAS robots
- Unmanned Aircraft Systems performing dynamic operations in an aviary
- Unmanned Underwater Vehicles performing inspection and retrieval tasks in a water tank
- Manufacturing and 3-D printing demos from local maker spaces, including opportunities to design and demo platforms to drive on robot test courses
